



Hosea Coleman, Sr. (1844-1911), brother of Elijah Coleman, built this home on Woodstock Road. Constructed of hand-hewn timbers, the front parlor rooms of this house have triple-hung windows, which, when raised, create walkways onto the front porch. In 1914, Hosea's widow applied for a pension and listed her assets as fourteen acres of land valued at \$300, two mules at \$200, and one cow at \$30. The barn for this homestead was replaced by a house in 1966.
