 Seller and Buyer acknowledge and agree that the purchase agreement they are considering involves representation by a Disclosed Dual Agent. The following information details the roles of the parties regarding Dual Agency.

Note: When the term "DUAL AGENT" is used, it will always mean the Broker (Berkshire Hathaway HomeServices The Preferred Realty) who, by contracts previously entered into, represents the interests of both the Buyer and the Seller in this agreement. The term DUAL AGENT will apply to a Salesperson/Associate Broker only if the same Salesperson/Associate Broker has been previously identified as the Designated Agent to represent the interests of both parties (Buyer and Seller) named in this agreement.
