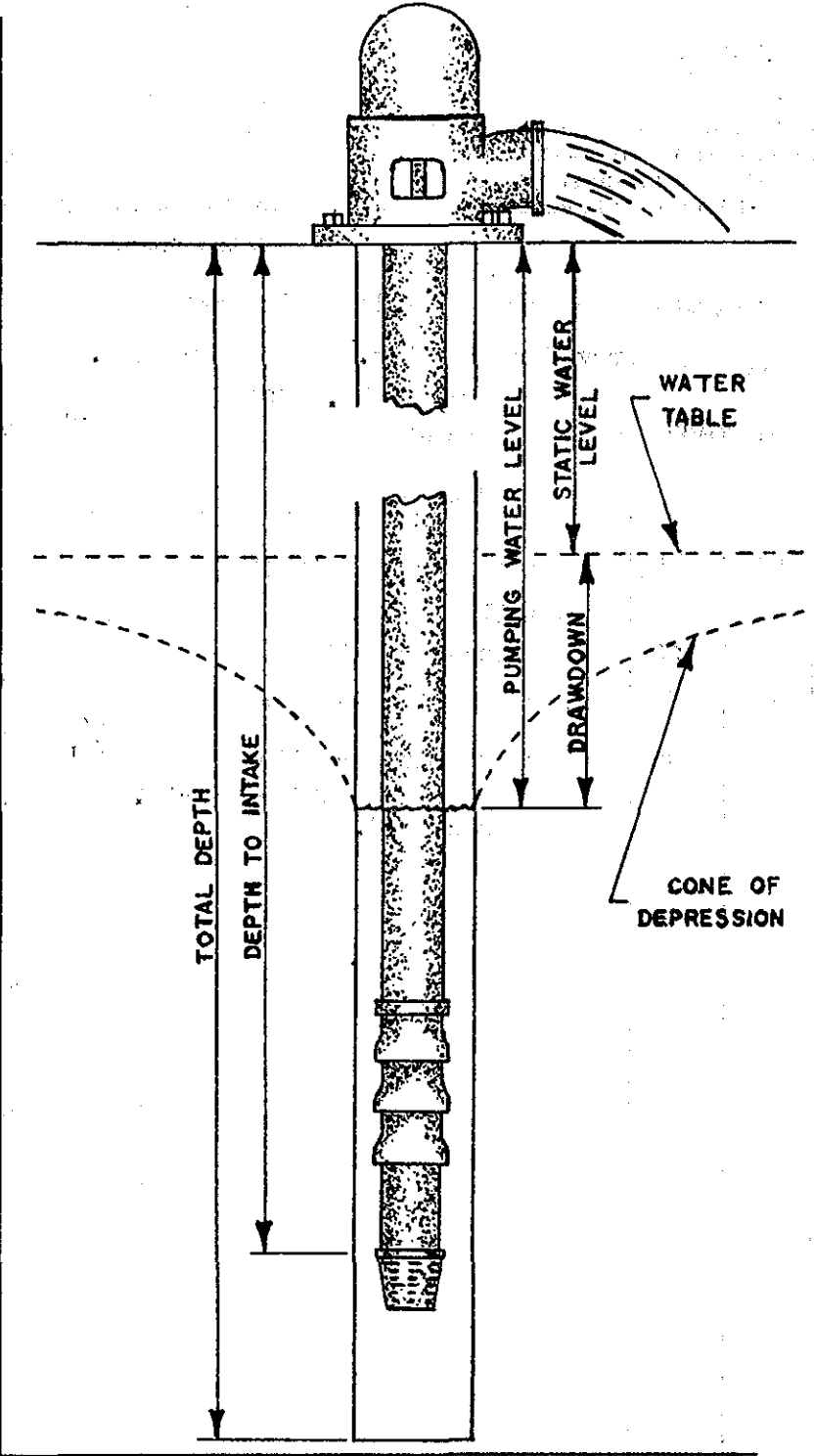

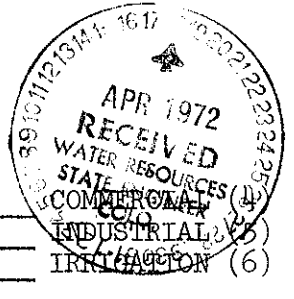

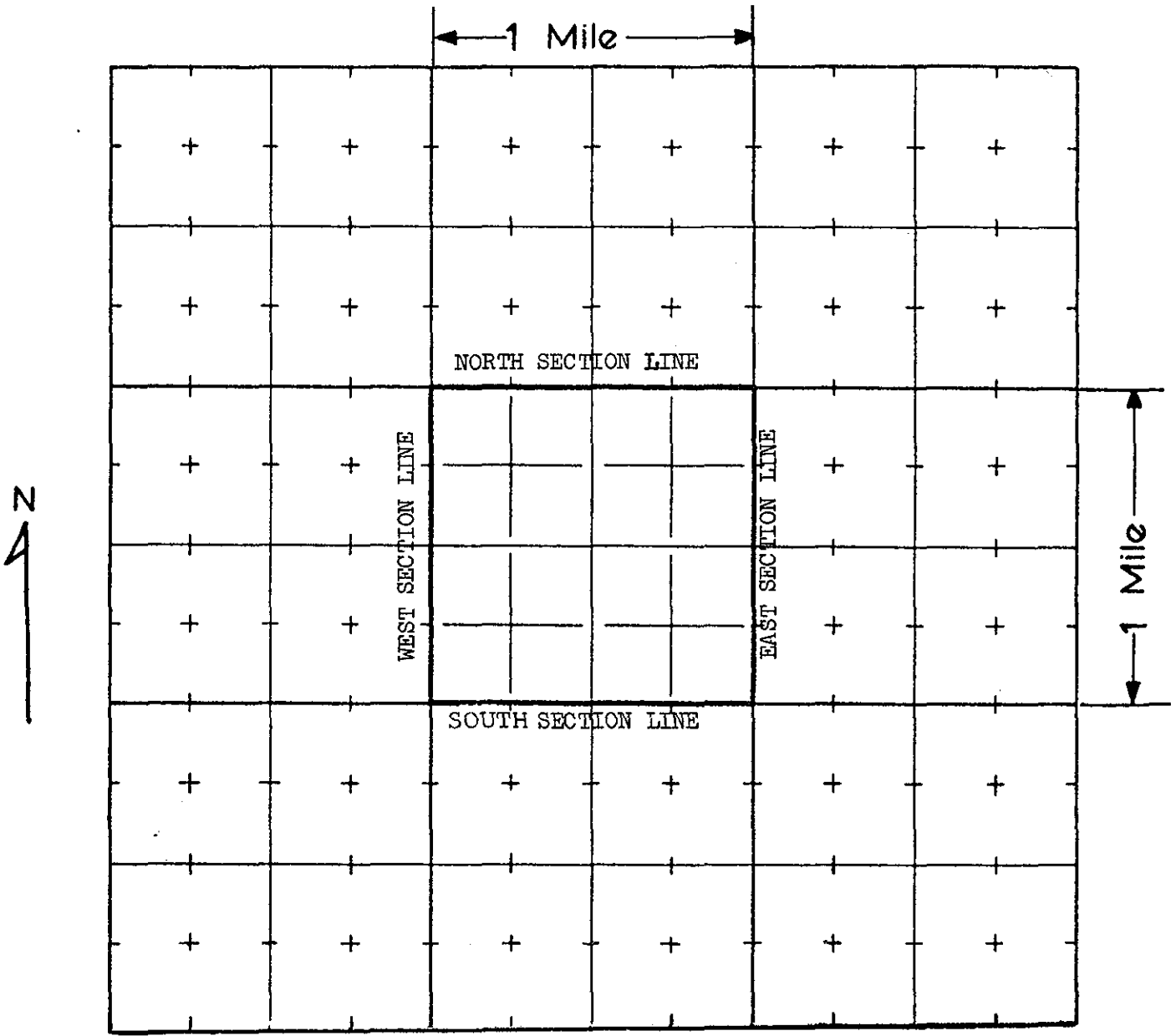

I am the attorney for Charles and Marlene Jimerson, who purchased the property in Jefferson County that is the subject of the above entitled permit number. This property was bought from Evaristo Morales in July of 1973. A copy of the permit is attached hereto for your information.

It is my understanding that upon good cause shown, this permit would be extended for a period of time after the expiration date. My client wishes me to apply, in his behalf, for such an extension and show as grounds the following:

Mr. and Mrs. Jimerson's present address is P.O. Box 5268, Arabian American Oil Company, Dhahran, Saudi Arabia, and they contemplate remaining there for a period of approximately four more years. However, Mr. Jimerson anticipates being in Colorado perhaps in the Fall of 1974 or Summer of 1975. They intend to construct a permanent home on this property and upon their return from overseas, to live there. Due to the problems in communication between Colorado and Arabia, I am their attorney in fact as well as in law. POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, CHARLES BEAMAN JIMERSON and MARLENE BOOTH JIMERSON, of Box 512, Springhill, Louisiana 71075, being about to depart from the United States and to reside for a time abroad, hereby appoint JERRY C. CONNELL, of 2921 North Speer Boulevard, Denver, Colorado 80211, our true and lawful attorney to act in, manage, and conduct all our affairs, and for that purpose in our names and on our behalf to do and execute all or any of the following acts, deeds and things:

1. To Receive Debts, etc. To ask, demand, sue for, recover, and receive all sums of money, debts, dues, goods, wares, merchandise, chattels, effects, and things of whatsoever nature or description which now are or hereafter shall be or become due, owing, payable, or belonging to us in or by any right, title, ways, or means howsoever, and upon receipt thereof or of any part thereof to make, sign, execute, and deliver such receipts, releases, or other discharges for the same respectively as he shall think fit or be advised.

2. To Settle Accounts. To settle any account or reckoning whatsoever wherein we now are or at any time hereafter shall be in any wise interested or concerned with any person whomsoever, and to pay or receive the balance thereof as the case may require.

3. To Satisfy Mortgages. To receive every sum of money which now is or hereafter shall be due or belonging to us upon the security or by virtue of any mortgage and on receipt of the full amount secured thereby to execute a good and sufficient release or other discharge of such mortgage by deed or otherwise.

4. To Compromise and Submit to Arbitration. To compromise with or make allowances to any person for or in respect to any debt or demand whatsoever which now is or shall at any time hereafter become due and payable to us, and to take and receive any composition or dividend thereof or thereupon, and to give releases or other discharges for the whole of such debts or demands, or to submit to arbitration every such debt or demand and every other right, matter, and thing due to or concerning us as our attorney shall think best, and for that purpose to enter into and execute and deliver such bonds of arbitration or other instruments as our attorney may deem advisable in the premises.

5. To Prosecute and Defend. To commence, prosecute, discontinue, or defend all actions or other legal proceedings touching our estate or any part thereof, or touching any matter in which we or our estate may be in any wise concerned.

6. To Manage Real Estate. To enter into and upon all and singular our real estate, and to let, manage, and improve the same or any part thereof, and to repair or otherwise improve or alter, and to insure any buildings thereon.

7. 9.
