HISTORIC PHOENIX THEATRE RENOVATION

Originally built as a Church in 1907 and later home to the Phoenix Theater; this historically significant building has been lovingly re-imagined. The original owners took great care to preserve the integrity in the building out of unit #A including; original floor beams as shelving, bricks as facings on stairs and incorporating exposed multi level brick walls. Light streams in from the double paned stained glass windows and highlights exceptional high end industrial architecture and finishes throughout. Roof top balcony with unending views of Indy flanks the massive primary suite with spa bath, walk-in closet and laundry. Two-car private garage features hydraulic lift. Centrally located in the heart of Chatham Arch, just blocks away from Mass Ave and Bottleworks.
