ACCOUNTABILITY RATING SYSTEM

Texas Schools Accountability Rating System

The Texas Schools Accountability Rating System is a framework for educational assessment and accountability established by the Texas Education Agency (TEA). Its purpose is to evaluate the performance of public schools and districts throughout the state. This system measures and reports on the academic progress and achievements of students, schools, and districts.

The Texas Accountability System utilizes a mix of standardized test scores, graduation rates, and various performance indicators to assess the quality of education provided. Its goal is to inform parents, educators, policymakers, and the public about school performance and highlight areas that may require improvement.

Overview

The accountability system is structured to evaluate performance across three domains:

Student Achievement: This domain assesses performance across all subjects for all students through general and alternate assessments, including College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) indicators and graduation rates.

School Progress: This measures outcomes at district and campus levels in two areas: the number of students who have shown at least one year of academic growth (or are on track) as indicated by STAAR results, and the overall achievement of students compared to those in districts or campuses with similar percentages of economically disadvantaged students.

Closing the Gaps: This domain uses disaggregated data to show disparities among different racial/ethnic groups, socioeconomic backgrounds, and other factors. The indicators in this domain, along with its structure, align with the state accountability system and the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA).

Rating Labels

Districts and campuses receive an overall rating along with a rating for each domain. The rating labels are as follows:

A, B, or C: These are assigned based on overall performance and performance in each domain to districts and campuses (including those evaluated under alternative education accountability (AEA)) that meet the performance target for the letter grade.

Not Rated: This label indicates that a district or campus does not receive a rating for one or more reasons, such as lack of data in the accountability subset, insufficient data to assign a rating, operation as a residential facility, or being a juvenile campus.

Not Rated (Senate Bill 1365): Assigned in 2022 for overall performance to districts and campuses that do not meet the performance target to achieve at least a C.

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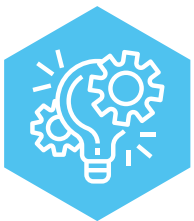
