1. **One-of-a-Kind Scribe-Fit Log Home ?** This is not a kit home and the logs are not milled. Each natural, round log was individually hand-peeled, scribed, notched, and grooved to fit the log beneath it. The home was engineered specifically to accommodate the natural settling of the logs.
2. **Warm, Open & Sun-Filled Interior ?** The open-concept living space features a loft, beautiful round-log timber trusses, and large gable windows that fill the home with natural light.
3. **Made for Gathering.** The practical, open floor plan is especially well suited for potluck dinners, holiday gatherings, book clubs, music, dancing, and evenings spent with friends and family.
4. **Full of Whimsical Custom Details.** Half-log counters, a log archway, the unique Raven's Nest indoor treehouse platform, and a corner log counter that creates a cozy, cave-like nook, especially perfect for a dog.
5. **A True Country Kitchen.** Granite countertops provide plenty of workspace, while the movable kitchen island can be repositioned depending on how the space is being used.
6. **Cozy Wood Heat & Fieldstone Hearth.** A woodstove set on a fieldstone hearth creates the quintessential log-home atmosphere and provides wonderful warmth during New Hampshire winters.
7. **Room to Garden & Grow.** Established gardens include asparagus, fruit, berries, and herbs, offering the opportunity to enjoy food grown right outside your door.
