Area Parks

Alpha Park
 Boasting over 18 acres of family recreation including a softball complex, a 9 basket disc golf course, a basketball court, 2 large pavilions, 2 playgrounds, walking trails, and a clubhouse. Both pavilions and the clubhouse can be rented throughout the year. There are small grills outside of each pavilion.

Grapevine Lake
 Located just south of Bartonville, this lake is a popular destination for outdoor recreation and scenic relaxation. Anglers enjoy catching largemouth bass, catfish, and crappie, while families take advantage of sandy swim beaches and picnic areas.
