(Floors) 1. The floors in the step-down living room have been damaged over the years. In 2013, the toilet backed up and overflowed. The water flowed out of the toilet and down into the step-down living room by going through the wall behind the toilet and into the step-down living room and kitchen area. I filed an insurance claim for the damage. The floors in the step-down living room were pulled up and replaced.

2. The dishwasher broke in 2023, and water leaked into the area immediately after the step into the living room. The water damaged the floors in that specific area, but they were not replaced.

(Ceilings) There have been settling cracks over the years to both the ceilings and the walls.

(Foundation/Slab(s)) We have noticed cracks to the drywall in both the ceilings and the walls over the years due to settling of the foundation.

(Walls/Fences) The fences are old and missing pickets. There are some areas of the fence where the posts no longer function as intended and should be replaced.



(Interior Walls) There have been cracks in the drywall due to settling over the years.

(Windows) The windows are old. There are cracked window panes in some of the windows.

(Plumbing Systems) In 2013, the toilet backed up. We had a plumber put a camera down the line. The pipe was cast iron and roots had grown through it. The line was replaced with PVC.

(Exterior Walls) The bottom edges of some of the siding pieces are damaged. A few years ago, a trim piece was added over the siding with the worst damage (located next to the back deck).

(Lead-Based Paint or Lead-Based Hazards) The house was built in 1970 so possibly has lead-based paint.

(Settling) Over the years, we have seen cracks in the drywall in both the walls and ceilings of the house, and we believe this is due to settling.

(Soil Movement) We have seen cracks in the drywall in both the walls and ceilings, and we believe this is due to settling of the house, which we believe could have resulted from soil movement.

(Water Damage Not Due to a Flood Event) In 2013, the toilet backed up and overflowed. The water flowed out of the toilet and down into the step-down living room and kitchen by going through the wall behind the toilet and into these two areas. I filed an insurance claim for the damage. The insurance company assigned Gerloff Company to do the repair work. They removed the bottom section of the drywall in the bathroom and the bottom section of the drywall in the step-down family room and replaced it. They removed the baseboard in the kitchen and replaced it, and they replaced the wood floors in the step-down

living room.

There are a few areas in the house where the wood floors do not seem to be fully secured/glued to the flooring underneath and move a bit when you step on them.

"500-year floodplain" means any area of land that: (A) is identified on the flood insurance rate map as a moderate flood hazard area, which is designated on the map as Zone X (shaded); and (B) has a two-tenths of one percent annual chance of flooding, which is considered to be a moderate risk of flooding.
