Train Commute to Manhattan (NYC)

From: 10 Reid Avenue, Bloomfield, NJ

To: New York Penn Station (Midtown Manhattan)

Nearest Train Station

Bloomfield Station (NJ Transit – Montclair-Boonton Line)

Approximately **5-minute drive** (or about 1.5 miles) from the property.

Train Line

NJ Transit Montclair-Boonton Line

Direct Midtown service is available during peak periods, with some off-peak trips requiring a transfer at Newark Broad Street.

Estimated Travel Time

Morning Commute: 40–50 minutes

Evening Return: 40–55 minutes

Estimated Cost

One-Way: Approximately **\$8.50–\$9.50**

Round Trip: Approximately **\$17–\$19**

Monthly Pass: Approximately **\$220–\$250**

Inbound to NYC: 6:00 AM – 9:00 AM

Outbound to NJ: 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM

Bus Commute to Manhattan (NYC)

Nearby Bus Service

NJ Transit buses provide convenient service to **Port Authority Bus Terminal (42nd Street & 8th Avenue)**, offering another excellent commuting option into Midtown Manhattan. Depending on your preferred route, service is available from nearby Bloomfield and Montclair stops.

Morning Commute: 45–60 minutes

Evening Return: 50–70 minutes

Estimated Cost

One-Way: Approximately \$7–\$9

Round Trip: Approximately \$14–\$18
