

Train Commute to Manhattan (NYC)

From: 15 Poe Ave, Bloomfield, NJ

To: New York Penn Station (Midtown Manhattan)

Nearest Train Station

Watsessing Train Station (NJ Transit – Montclair-Boonton Line)

Approximately 5–10 minute drive from Poe Ave.

Train Line

NJ Transit Montclair-Boonton Line – Midtown Direct (no transfers required).

Estimated Travel Time

Morning commute: 35–45 minutes

Evening return: 40–50 minutes

Estimated Cost

One-way ticket: \$9–\$13

Round trip: \$18–\$26

Monthly pass: Approximately \$230–\$300

Peak Travel Hours

Inbound to NYC: 5:30 AM – 9:30 AM

Outbound to NJ: 4:00 PM – 7:30 PM

Bus Commute to Manhattan (NYC)

From: 15 Poe Ave, Bloomfield, NJ

To: Port Authority Bus Terminal (Midtown Manhattan)

Nearest Bus Pickup

Bloomfield Ave corridor (short drive or walk from Poe Ave).

Common pickup areas include Bloomfield Ave near Allwood Rd or Glenwood Ave.

Bus Service

NJ Transit interstate bus routes serving Bloomfield to NYC (Port Authority).

Direct service to Midtown Manhattan.

Estimated Travel Time

Morning commute: 50–70 minutes (traffic dependent).

Evening return: 55–75 minutes.

Estimated Cost

One-way ticket: \$7–\$12

Round trip: \$14–\$24

Monthly pass: Approximately \$180–\$300

Peak Travel Hours

Inbound to NYC: 6:00 AM – 9:30 AM
