

410 D Main Street, Red River, NM

History. While now impossible to date with total accuracy, the cabin is approximately ninety to 100 years old as of 2026. It was initially erected at “Three Canyon Camp,” a tourist camp located just west of Mallette Road, between Main Street and High Street – its location is precisely where the Eisenhut Condominiums are currently situated. Three Canyon Camp was subsequently sold and the name changed to “Lone Pine Camp.” Lone Pine Camp ceased operations in the late 1960s. Many of the cabins were subsequently purchased and moved hither and thither throughout town. This particular cabin was purchased by Mr. Archie Weatherford and moved to its current location in approximately 1972. Another, smaller “Lone Pine” cabin was likewise relocated just next to it (410 C Main St.) Names of tourists and visitors from its former role as a tourist cabin – most likely teenagers – can be faintly seen on the knotty pine door of the bathroom and elsewhere in the cabin. The shellacked knotty pine planks on the interior walls (as well the bedroom ceiling) are original to the cabin.

Improvements / Renovations: 410 D Main Street (“cabin”)

- New carpet in den, bedroom, stairs, loft, circa 2021. Professionally installed by Ralph Rael & Son.
- New bathroom sink and stand installed circa 2020.
- New hot water heater installed circa 2018.
- Electric wall heater units installed in den and main bedroom in approximately 2012.
- Crawl space and piping insulated circa 2022.
- Exterior siding replaced with charred Japanese cypress circa 2022. I have literature on the siding and company at home. Custom steel wainscoat from Bridger Steel installed on north and east faces of cabin.
- Pre-existing wood decking removed in approximately 2022 and replaced with Trex/Tivek decking.
- New Sierra-Pacific roll-out double-pane aluminum-clad windows installed throughout the cabin in approximately 2022. The original windows are stored beneath the cabin.
- Electric wiring has been professionally checked at least twice for safety in the past eighteen years.
- Vintage Bakelite 1930s-40s switch and outlet plates installed circa 2024.
- New metal roof installed in 2008.
