HB2102, the new deductibles law, goes into effect September 1st. It is a modification and expansion of the deductibles law that's been around for many years that requires owners to pay their insurance deductible and "punished" contractors who waived - or ate - deductibles. While there were lots of complaints about how vague the law was, it wasn't vague so much as rife with loopholes. The new law is much broader and will be much harder to maneuver around which is good for property owners and contractors alike.
